

RESOLUTION 20-0317

PROCLAMATION OF EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY: TOWN OF ALTOONA

WHEREAS, in accordance with State Law, the Town of Altoona and the jurisdictions therein, empowers the Town Council of the Town of Altoona to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local PUBLIC HEALTH state of emergency, when said the Town of Altoona is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity; and

WHEREAS, Mayor, Richard Nash of the Town of Altoona, To Proclaim the existence of a Local Public Health State of Emergency therein; and

WHEREAS, said Town of Altoona does hereby find;

Due to Alabama Department of Public Health's declaration of a public health emergency conditions do exist and have now affected life to such a degree that a Proclamation of a Local Public Health Emergency is warranted for Etowah County this should include COVID-19, Hepatitis A and Influenza.

The aforesaid conditions of extreme peril warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a local state of emergency;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED that a local public health state of emergency now exists throughout the Town of Altoona; and



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
